### Compliment to a Charlotte Lady.

In a letter to the Augusta Constitutionalist, from the Warm Springs, in this State, the following paragraph occurs: "Among the most notable visitors, I will first mention, with a respectful bow, the widow of the immortal Stonewall Jackson, who reached here, in company with her little daughter, (11 years old) a few days since. Mrs. Jackson is quite young. I should say between 25 and 30, of medium height, and beautiful face. She lives now at Charlotte, in this State."

### A Curious Rock—

Capt. A. Tanner, a contractor on the Carolina Central Railway, brought in a rock yesterday, which is worthy of a place in some museum. It was taken out of the earth nineteen feet below the surface, one mile this side of McAlpine's Creek, on the land of Mr. Brown Wallace, and is very similar to the rock which was taken out of Boggan's Cut some time since. It has clearly entangled upon it the shapes of trees and undergrowth, all painted as with the most delicate pencil of an artist. When we consider that this came from nineteen feet under the ground, and the piece in our possession came from the centre of a solid rock, the explanations which we have had of the mystery are not satisfactory. ### Postal Regulations.

The following notes a few of the changes made in the postal regulations by the act of last session: Letters with requests to return printed or written matter are to be returned without additional postage. When a subscriber to a newspaper changes his residence and desires his paper forwarded to his new office, transition rates of postage of one cent for each two ounces or fraction thereof must be charged on each copy as received. If a party receives a paper from the office of publication and wishes it to be mailed by post of one cent for each two ounces or fraction thereof. Letters once taken up for mailing without the proper parties being present, may be mailed without being prepaid. This applies also to return letters once taken up of a postoffice. Letters to be mailed without additional postage.

### Excursion to Kings Mountain.

On Sunday, an excursion train for colored people left this city for Kings Mountain, on the Air-Line Railroad. There was quite a large crowd on board, and they were met at their stopping place by a crowd of colored people from Crowder's Mountain, and other places. When the time came for the departure for the mountain (the railroad station for Kings Mountain is Kings Mountain) the negroes from Crowder's took possession of the coaches, and began all manner of profanity. They positively refused to get out, and in every way possible rendered themselves disagreeable. Finally, the Charlotte negroes resorted to extreme measures, and by main force, ejected one or two of the intruders from the cars. Then the row became general, and they set the revolutionary battle at Kings Mountain wasn't a cock-fight compared with it. Knives, sticks and pistols were used with a terrible carnage and effect; many a head had an indentation made in it, and many a human arm dived so beautifully carried. Knives and pistols glistened like burnished silver in the rays of the declining sun, and blood flowed and trickled like mountain brooks.

### Serious Accident.

A serious accident happened yesterday evening between 6 and 7 o'clock, to a little son of Mr. James Manning of this city. The little fellow, who is about 9 years of age, while he was watching him, got his father's powder flask, containing between half pint and a pint of powder, and with 3 younger brothers, went into the back yard with a coal of fire to have some fun. The eldest boy poured some powder on the ground and applied the fire. The explosion frightened him, so that he dropped the bottle, and the train communicating to it, caused the whole to burst with a loud noise. A part of the bottle struck the leg of the largest boy, cutting a deep gash and causing a painful wound. In addition to this the side of his face and back of his neck was much burned, and one sleeve of his coat was burned off.

### Class—Dead Weight Unloaded.

On yesterday about three o'clock Silas Ferguson, a colored man at the store of J. Davidson, colored, who had tried to sell Davidson, about 40 or 50 pounds of good Rio Coffee. Davidson refused to buy, but informed Silas of the facts, and he believing that the coffee had been stolen, pursued the supposed thief, with a view of investigating the matter. Not being able to catch up with him himself he called to his aid Walter Alexander and Jim Boyd, both boys who went for him in true 2-40 style. The fugitive was too fast for them but carrying 40 pounds of dead weight, he was captured in the language of President Grant, the time had come when it was good policy to "unload." He did unload by leaving the coffee on the wayside, and it was gathered up by the purveyor and brought to this office.
