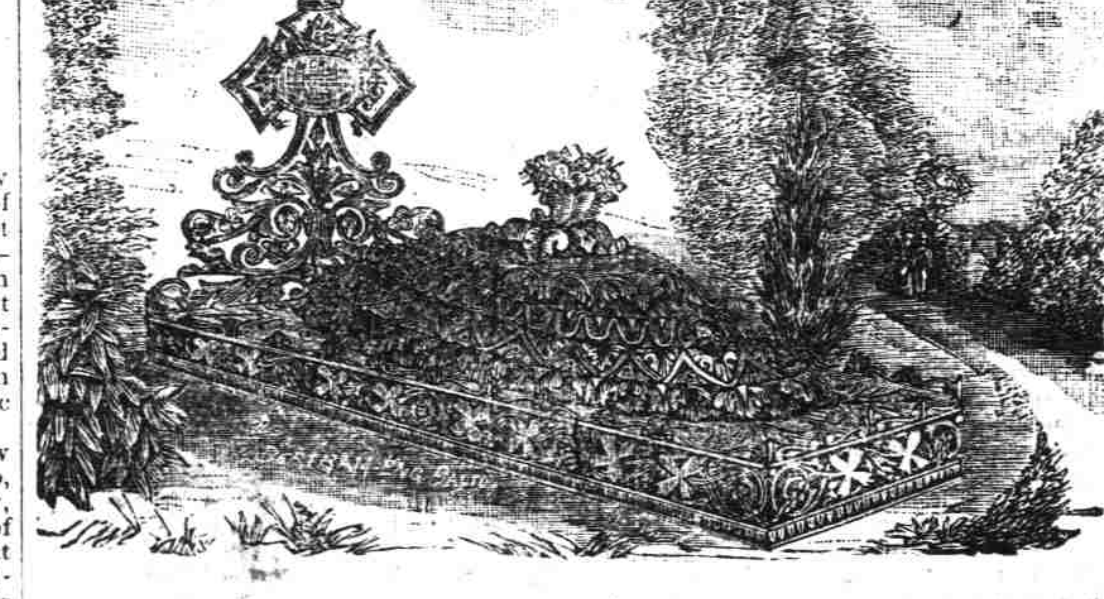

The attention of all Merchants and Traders, doing business in the city, is called to the following extract from the city tax bill of the current year: And notice is hereby given to all such merchants and traders to make return to me at my office, on January 1st, 1875, of their purchases made for the six months preceding said date. By order of the Board of Aldermen **F. NASH, Clerk and Treas.**

Sec. 21, Chap. II. "There shall be levied annually, on all merchants and traders, a tax of one fifth of one percent on all goods, wares and merchandise, purchased out of the State, to be collected semi-annually."
