NEW ADVERTISEMENTS. COUNTY BONDS AT AUCTION. By C. F. HARRISON. This Thursday morning April 1st, at 12, promptly, I will sell at the Court House door, \$2500 of Mecklenburg county Bonds.

AN ACT TO ASCERTAIN THE INDEBTEDNESS OF THE SEVERAL COUNTIES, CITIES AND TOWNS OF THIS STATE, and to prescribe a Statute of Limitations.

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF NORTH CAROLINA do enact: SECTION 1. That all claims against the several counties, cities and towns of this State, whether by bond or otherwise, shall be presented to the chairman of the Board of County Commissioners to the chief officer of said cities and towns, as the case may be, within two years after the maturity of such claim or claims or the holders of such claim or claims, shall be forever barred from a recovery thereof.

SECTION 2. That it shall be the duty of the chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of the several counties or the chief officers of the several cities and towns, to cause the nature, amount, date and time of maturity of all claims so presented to be recorded in a book to be kept for that purpose and to be called "The Registry of Claims."

SECTION 3. It shall be the duty of the Secretary of State to publish this act for six consecutive weeks in the Daily News, Era and Sentinel newspapers, published in this city; in the Greenboro Patriot, published in the city of Greensboro; the Asheville Citizen, published in the town of Asheville; the North Carolina Gazette, published in Fayetteville.

SECTION 4. This act shall not apply to any county whose debts are already audited, and ascertained. This act shall take effect from and after its ratification.
