

STATE NEWS.

There are now 37 orphans in the Asylum at Asheville. A large number of tobacco plants have been killed by cold in Orange county.

John C. McKinnon, a former resident of Richmond county, is a member of the Texas legislature.

Hon. W. M. Robbins, of Statesville, will deliver the Annual Address before the Literary Societies of Wake Forest College, next June.

On Tuesday last Mr. R. J. Nixon of Grant township, Pender county, met with the misfortune of having destroyed by fire his barn and stables, valued at \$3,000.

The Baptists of North Carolina have 100,000 members, white and colored, 750 churches, and 450 ministers, 36 students for the ministry are in their seminaries.

A colored man by the name of Henry Mitchell, sometimes called Henry Morris, was accidentally drowned in the Cape Fear, not far from Wilmington, on Tuesday night.

At the request of Judge Kerr, Judge Seymour has consented to hold Orange Court to Geo. W. Swepson, Esq., on the first Monday in May and the arrangement only awaits consent of Gov. Brogden.

Wilmington Review: Mr. Joseph H. Dulles, an old respected citizen of Philadelphia, died on Sunday last, aged 81 years.

The shipments of fertilizers over the South Carolina Railroad to the end of February, aggregate 25,196 tons, exceeding by 2,000 tons, any previous year to that date, since 1870.

A gentleman residing in Anderson county, has informed the editor of the Intelligencer, that all the colored men who were under verbal contract to work for him this year, have declined to do so.

Means, and was on his return home, when, it is supposed, he either fell from his horse and was killed by the fall, or died from an apoplectic fit.
