C., Aug. 11.-News from Terry's camp August 3d, says that his reinforcements have arrived. Horses are scarce. Orders were given on the evening of the second to commence the march. Two steamers ferried the command across the Yellow Stone to the mouth of the Rosebud. Gen Gibbon's command takes the advance. Terry's command is in excellent spirits, and ready to second the efforts of their commander, to avenge the death of Custer and his men.
