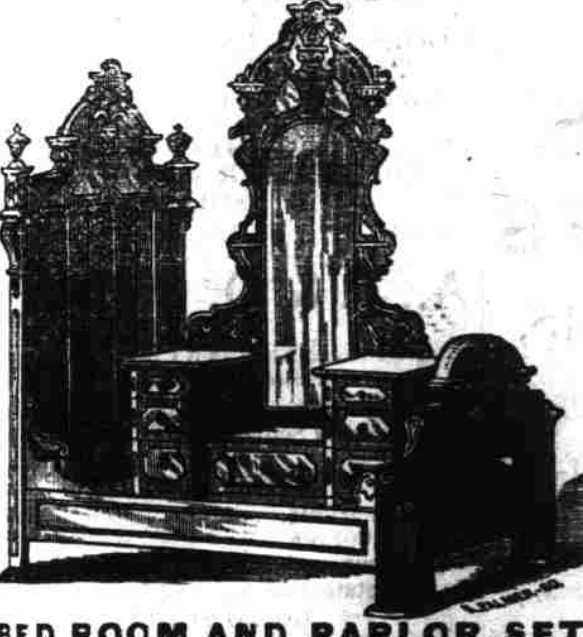

FOREIGN.

Particulars of Tweed's Arrest—Turko-Serbian War Items.

LONDON, Sept 11.—A special dispatch from Burgos to the Daily News, states that Tweed was arrested at Pondevedra, where he landed from a sailing vessel on which he escaped from Cuba. Mr Adle, in charge of affairs of the United States in the absence of Minister Cushing, visited the Spanish minister of foreign affairs at La Grange, and arranged for the surrender of the prisoner to the American Government. The Spanish authorities had been notified of Tweed's sailing for Spain, and preparations had been made for his arrest, long before his arrival.
