Disarmament of the Turkish People - Servia will negotiate with Turkey-Turkey's Peace Proposals Moderate and Conciliatory.

LONDON, Jan 29.-Dispatches report the basis of peace offered by Turkey to Servia and Montenegro as moderate and very conciliatory.

The Electoral Bill Signed by the President - Action of Extreme Republican Senators to Secure Grant's Recognition of the Packard Government - Thurman and Bayard Democratic Senators of the Grand Commission.

WASHINGTON.

President Grant's Message to Congress Approving the Bill for Counting the disputed Electoral Votes.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 29. The President sent the following message to Congress approving the Bill for counting the electoral votes:

To the Senate of the United States: I follow the example heretofore occasionally presented, of communicating in this my approval of the act, 'To provide for, and regulate the counting of the votes for President and Vice President, and the decision of questions arising thereon, for the term commencing March 4th, A. D. 1877.'
