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TURKEY AND RUSSIA.

Preparations for the Coming Conflict—Servian Envoy Treated with Respect at Constantinople.

LONDON, Feb 19.—It stated that 8,000 Russian engineers are altering the gauge of the Roumanian roads to conform with those of Russia. The work will be completed in 20 days.

Advices from Rome says that it has been concluded that the new Pope may be elected without regard to nationality.

A Reuter's dispatch from Rutchuck, Bulgaria, says: "The number of Turkish troops quartered in the villages along the Danube has increased from 60,000 on the 31st of January, to 75,000. The Garrison of Rutchuck numbers 12,000 men."

A Reuter's dispatch from Belgrade says: "Negotiations are progressing satisfactorily, and it is expected that a treaty of peace will be ready to submit to the Great Skuptschina on the 26th inst."
