

London, May 30. - The Turkish government has decided to admit foreigners into its army. A number of English gentlemen who have had experience in the English army are about to join the Ottoman forces, including the Hen W Drummond.

Ex-President Grant will drive with the Prince of Wales at Pierrepont's en the 21st of June.

The Times' special from Rome states that King Victor Emanuel has written to the Pope congratulating him on the approaching anniversary. The Pope has sent a reply thanking the King and taking occasion to beg him net to permit the Italian government to dispoil the parishes and confraternities of their property, stating that otherwise he should be constrained to protest. The King has made no reply to the Pope's missive.
