A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR.

\$200 Reward.

EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT, Raleigh, August 10th, 1877.

WHEREAS, official information has been received at this Department that RUFUS LORANCE, late of the county of Mecklenburg, stands charged with the murder of DOCK HURSTON, of said county;

And WHEREAS, it appears that the said RUFUS LORANCE has fled the State, or so conceals himself that the ordinary process of law cannot be served upon him;

Now, therefore, I, ZEBULON B. VANCE, Governor of the State of North Carolina, by virtue of authority in me vested by law, do issue this my proclamation, offering a reward of Two Hundred Dollars for the apprehension and delivery of the said RUFUS LORANCE to the Sheriff of Mecklenburg county, at this office, in said county; and I do join all officers of the State and all good citizens to assist in bringing said criminal to justice.

Done at our city of Raleigh, the tenth day of August, 1877, at the 102nd year of American Independence.
