Under the Revised Statutes of the United States, Sections 3232, 3237, 3238 and 3239, every person engaged in any business, avoidation, or employment, which renders him liable to a special tax, is required to "produre and place and keep conspicuously in his establishment or place of business is stamp" denoting the payment of said special tax for the special tax year beginning May 1, 1878. Section 3244, Revised Statutes, designates who are liable to special tax. A return as prescribed on Form 11, is also required by law of every person liable to special
