A Destructive Fire in Wilmington.

The Wilmington Star of Wednesday last, gives a lengthy report of the destructive conflagration which occurred in that city on the morning previous, as briefly noticed in THE OBSERVER of Wednesday.

The flames next appeared in a warehouse on the corner of Front street and Mutter's alley, which was destroyed, together with the residence of Mr. J. Loeb, near by.

The Star gives the following as the losses and insurance: The steamship S. Underhill, the property of Mr. O. G. Parsley, Jr., is insured for about her full value, \$3,000.

Mr. J. E. Lippitt owned all but one of the buildings destroyed, and his loss upon the various stores, warehouses, sheds and stables amounted in the aggregate to about \$17,000, upon which there was only \$7,500 insurance.

Mr. J. B. Eilers lost 800 barrels of resin and had a small lot of spirits turpentine destroyed, valued at about \$1,500, insured for \$2,000.
