GRANT IN PHILADELPHIA. The Republican League, declaring that it will not support him.

PHILADELPHIA, May 26.—The National Republican League of Philadelphia has just adopted the following resolution:

Resolved, That the National Republican League of Philadelphia, in sending delegates to Chicago, instructs them to declare that the members of the league will not vote under any circumstances for Gen. Grant, but will support any other nominee of the Chicago convention.

Among the delegates are Wayne MacVeagh, W. Roth Wister, Wharton Barker, H. C. Lea, and Prof. Selden Stricker.

At the meeting the greatest enthusiasm prevailed, and the delegates will start for Chicago to work against Grant Sunday night, and will be joined on the way by anti-the Grant workers from Harrisburg, Altoona, and various other cities in the State.

They also expect to meet workers from New York and Massachusetts. The leaders here say there will be 600 anti-third-termers on the ground at Chicago.

They will hold a meeting there the day before the Republican convention and decide upon what action to take.

Making Lumber Out of Straw. The versatile ingenuity of a Western inventor, who doubtless foresees the time in the far distant future when the forest shall cease to clothe the hills and dales, and the demand for lumber shall prove vastly in excess of the supply.

It is claimed that this process converts wheat straw into timber which is susceptible of as fine a polish and finish as mahogany and black walnut at a cost not in excess of that of the best clear pine.
