Opening of the Federal Court.

Railroad Damage.

The Air-line Railroad charges five cents per mile for the transportation of passengers over that portion of the road which lies in North Carolina and four cents per mile over that which is in Georgia, because the Georgia State line makes four cents the highest legal rate that can be charged on roads in that State.

Capt. Tom Murphy of the North Carolina Railroad is en route to Atlanta, Fayetteville to Mississippi, New Orleans, and the bridle party arrived in Wilmington by steamship, Friday evening.
