High Tide of Immigration.
The year 1880 is likely to be a memorable one in the annals of immigration.
It was in that year that the emigrant
tide from Europe to these shores touched
the highest mark ever known.
In 1880, 220,000 aliens were landed at
Castle Garden. The next best number
recorded in any preceding year was 210,000
in 1874. These figures are for New York
alone, the great gate through which
aliens enter the country. Including
the arrivals at other points the whole
number of European emigrants added to
the population of the United States
in 1880 was well on to half a million.
One of the most striking aspects of
last year's immigration is its enormous
excess over that of any other year
in the history of the country. The
arrivals at the port of New York
in 1870, nearly five times as many as
in 1878 and about six times as many as
in 1877. From the close of the war
down to 1878 the number of aliens
landed at Castle Garden did not fall
below 200,000 in any year. But from 1874
to 1877 it dropped to 140,000 in 1874,
64,000 in 1875, 68,000 in 1876 and 60,000
in 1877. It rose to 75,000 in 1878, 135,000
in 1879 and nearly 221,000 in 1880.
