The area of territory included within the northern third of Illinois and the southern quarter of Wisconsin and the whole State of Iowa, making about ninety thousand square miles, says the Chicago Tribune, is destined within a comparatively brief term, to become the greatest dairy garden for dairy products in the world.

Reports of the Number of Destitute—Much Loss of Life Apprehended.

MEMPIS, March 8.—The river continues stationary, with 36 feet on gauge, the highest point reached this season. No cessation of reports of the great suffering by the people in the overland districts. The reply to the inquiry of the Secretary of War as to the number of destitute in his State, Judge Mangum, commissioner for Arkansas, replied that he had information of 20,000, but the number increases daily. It is in needy condition in Mississippi and 5,000 in Tennessee, making 45,000 persons whose condition is such as to demand prompt attention at the hands of the government. The change in the weather has increased the suffering and many lives must be lost from exposure. Gov. Hawkins has appointed H. M. James commissioner for Tennessee to receive government supplies.

Mayor Grace's Citizenship Questioned.

NEW YORK, March 8.—It is rumored that there will be an investigation in regard to Mayor Grace's citizenship. The mayor himself admits that he took out his naturalization papers two days before the election, merely as a precautionary measure, as he was in Peru when he attained his majority.

Charter Filed.

GALVESTON Texas, March 8.—A Laredo special says: The Rio Grande Feeds railroad charter was filed last Friday with Gov. Alex. Hunt, of Colorado, ex-Gov. J. W. Throckmorton and Albert C. Wilcox, of Texas, as incorporators. The road is projected from Brownsville, near El Paso, on the western boundary. The road is contemplated to be built along the valley of the river, and the principal office is to be located at Laredo, where work has already begun.
