FROM RALEIGH. The Democratic Convention--A Splendid Body of Representative Men--Harmony Prevails and no Clashing of Rival Interests.

RALEIGH, July 5.--The Democratic State Convention assembled at 2 p. m. today in Tucker's Hall, in this city.

Not since the war has a more respectable and intelligent body of men been gathered together in the Old North State. Nearly every county in the State is represented.

Dozens of leading men representing both political parties occupied seats or stood within the hall and were interested spectators among the number ex-Senator Merzimon, Judge Fowle, Gov. Jarvis, Capt. A. R. Andrews, ex-Gov. Glenn, Col. L. J. Young, Dr. J. G. Grissom, Postmaster Nicholas, of Raleigh, and others.

The galleries were filled. Some two hundred or more colored men occupied seats in them.

The address to the convention, a majority of whom arrived on Tuesday night, caucused early and late. Causes were held this morning. Many delegates to the convention expressed the opinion that it would be better for the Democracy to assemble in convention and call upon the Governor to call a special session of the Legislature with the view of restricting the State so that there need be no election of congressmen at large.

At 6 p. m. the convention, (no platform having been reported,) adjourned until 8 p. m.

The Demands Cigarette. Nashville American: "It is said that in London there has been formed a national society for the suppression of juvenile smoking.
