His Honor reversed the ruling of the Probate Judge, and de-clared that the judgment oreditors mentioned were severally entitled to be paid in the order of time, and according to the several priorities of the docket-ing of their respective judgments, until by this appropriation the fund left after payment of costs and charges of administration is exhausted. From this judgment the plaintiff appeals. The court in affirming the ruling of his Honor says.

his Honor says: The argument as to the correctness of the method of distribution adopted in the probate court, is fully met by the statute which directs the order in which the debts of a decedant must be paid by his representative. The answer to the contention that the judgments rendered more than ten years before the bringing of the action are barred by the statute of limitations is furnished in section 48 of the code. is furnished in section 43 of the code. In order to qualify, so as to avoid misconception, attention is called to an expression used in Flemming vs Flem-ming, 85 N C, 127. It is there said to be "equally well settled that the death of the debtor after the cause of action has accrued will not suspend the run-ning of the statute to the completion of the prescribed time." This was intended to be the statement of a general princi-ple resting upon numerous decisions, and without reference to the modifica-tion made by the words of the act reand without reference to the mountca-tion made by the words of the act re-cited, and to which attention was not at the moment directed, and certainly with no intent to disregard or ignore the express statutory mandate. No error: Affirmed.
