HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

After a Skirmish on Public Buildings, The House Passes the Naval Appropriation Bill.

WASHINGTON, D. C., January 10.—House.—Immediately after the reading of the journal Randall moved to dispense with the morning hour for the purpose of pressing the naval appropriation bill to a passage.

This was strongly opposed by Stockslager, who maintained that the House should proceed to the consideration of the special order in reference to public buildings.

Stockslager replied with some warmth that he was performing what he considered his duty in contending for the execution of the special order.

Quite a brisk and apparently personal colloquy then sprang up between the two gentlemen, which resulted in the confusion in the hall was so great as to render their remarks unintelligible.

Stockslager demanded the yeas and nays on Randall's motion, which was lost, yeas 135, nays 83, the necessary two thirds not voting in the affirmative.

A STABBING AFFRAY.

Capt. Phelan Lured from Kansas City to New York and Attacked by an Assassin.

NEW YORK, Jan. 10.—Yesterday an effort was made in the office of O'Donovan Rossa to assassinate Captain Thomas Phelan, of Kansas City, who was suspected of betraying the secrets of the dynamite from an interview with him published in the Kansas City Times.

Phelan was lured to New York, in response to which letter he went away on the 8th. The day after he went to O'Donovan Rossa's office, where he was met in a friendly way by Kearney, there were present two other men whom he did not know.

Shortly after another man came in with a knife in his hand, walked directly up to Capt. Phelan who was sitting on a chair, and began slashing savagely at him with the knife, cutting him in several places, and nearly severing the right arm.

Phelan effected his escape into the street where he fell upon the sidewalk and was picked up by the police, and was sent to City Hall place, where he was arrested, blood being found on his pants and clothes. He accounted for the blood by saying that he was a butcher.
