Great Britain to ask for legislation that shall insure the sale of the stuff upon its merits and for just what it is. Last year there were exported from this country nearly 40,000,000 pounds of bogus butter and oleo oil, and England received her share of it. There has been laid before the Council of the British Dairy Farmer's Association and referred to a special committee a bill providing that all imitations of butter "shall be called by names clearly and entirely distinguishable from the word "butter," and from any modification or derivation of that word:" that all manuand from any modification of theriva-tion of that word;" that all manu-factories of bogus butter in Great Britain shall be registered; that bo-gus butter shall not be colored in im-itation of real butter, and that the bogus products shall be sold under their right names.

A CURIOUS WILL.

A Testator Who Makes Provision for the Propagation of Goats.

Rev. David Abel, a somewhat eccentric minister, who died recently in Burlington county, N. J., left a will which has already bothered the administrator, and it is not unlikely that he will prefer to surrender the trust rather than attempt to carry out all the wishes of the testator. The will provides first for the payment of all just debts and funeral expenses, and then directs that the residue be applied to the establishment of a Bible temperance school for the classical education of the young people of both sexes, the preference always being given to the family relatives of the testator. It also provides that the scholars shall pay a partion of their tuition by such manual labor as shall by rule be appointed them.

In it he desires his executor to make provis-ion, if possible, for the use of as large a portion of the ground devoted to school purposet as may be found available for the pasturing and propagation of goats, in order to en-courage the use of their flesh in place of that of swine as an article of food Rev.
