WATER COMMISSION WILL SUE

McCormick, Boardman and Campbell Will be the Defendants—Papers Served on McCormick.

Deputy Sheriff E. O. Johnston has served a summons upon W. T. McCormick, who was construction engineer for the new water-works plant of the city, and who will be one of the defendants in a suit that is being instituted by City Attorney Hugh W. Harris for the water commission. The other defendants in the suit will be Messrs. A. E. Boardman, who has gone abroad, and Mr. C. H. Campbell, of Atlanta, Ga. Mr. Boardman was consulting engineer for the new plant and Mr. Campbell was superintendent of the water-works department when the new plant was being constructed. The case will be made returnable at the April civil term of the Superior Court. An Observer reporter last evening saw City Attorney Harris and questioned him concerning the suit. Mr. Harris would say nothing as to the exact nature of the suit, stating that the complaint would be filed at the convening of court and that nothing would be given out until that time. Mr. McCormick, who has been in the city two or three days, has retained Tillett & Guthrie to represent him. Pharr & Bell will assist City Attorney Harris.

Joe Lee and Eugene McClain, two colored employees, chose to settle some personal differences while on duty. Eugene got the worst end of the bargain.
