COTTON UP & TO IT POINTS

After Early Weakness, the Market Held, Largely Because of Anticipation That May Notice Will be Stopped To-Day—Close Very Steady and Near the Top.

New York, April 26.—The cotton market recovered part of its recent loss due to the day's trading, largely as a result of covering by nearby shorts in preparation for notice day to-morrow. The close was very steady at a net advance of 1/16 to 1/8 points. Sales for the day were estimated at 20,000 bales.

The opening was steady at an advance of 1/16 to 1/8 points in response to steady sales. The market was very active and unsettled early, the weather was a good showing on the average, there was no sign of full support and the market soon came to a point of equilibrium.

Future opened quiet with prices about the same as yesterday's closing. Soon after the opening the market eased off slightly, this was followed by a sharp advance. Today was the first notice day for May in this market and some 3,700 notices were put out for that date, of which were soon stopped, but about 200 bales circulated for some time before being stopped.

Chicago, April 26.—Prediction of rain to be followed by cooler weather. Rain was caused weakness in the local wheat market to-day. At this close wheat for July delivery was 47 1/2 c.

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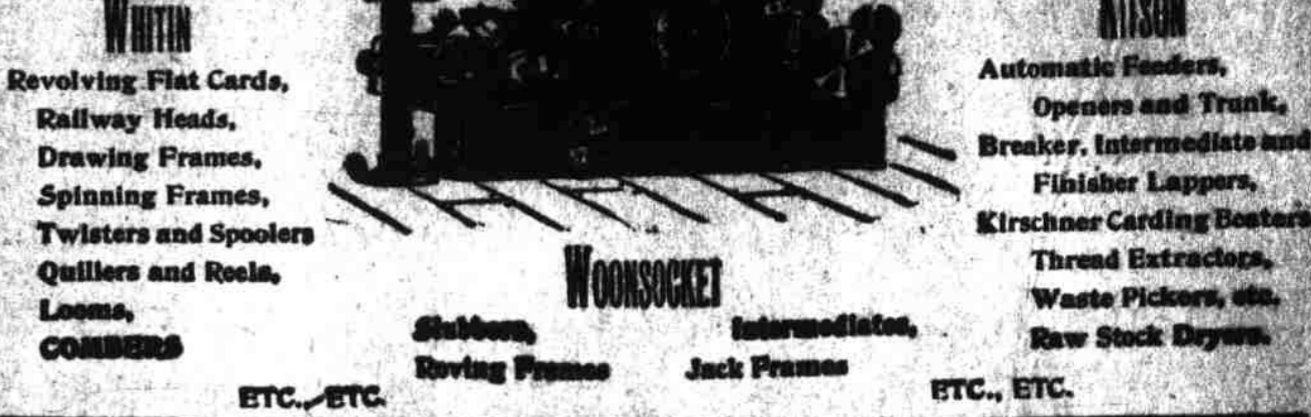
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
