

THIS DAY IN HISTORY

1704.—Percival White, the "first-born" of Plymouth colony, died at Marshfield, aged nearly 92.
1804.—Many thousands of bushels of wheat and flour arrived at Cadiz from the United States.
1814.—Private General Armstrong arrived at New York, having captured 11 vessels.
1814.—Gen. Brown moved his whole force upon Fort George, but, not being supported by the fleet on account of Commodore Boscawen's illness, fell back on the 22d to Queenstown.
1829.—The census of South Carolina showed a great decrease in population at Richmond.
1852.—The obsequies of Henry Clay celebrated with the greatest pomp and magnificence in New York. The city was shrouded in mourning, business was suspended and the stripping were their colors at half-mast.
1861.—The Confederate Congress met at Richmond, Va.
1863.—A cavalry expedition sent out by Gen. Foster struck the Wilmington & Weldon Railroad at Rocky Mount, N. C., burned the long bridge over Tar river, tore up two miles of track, destroyed the depot, a large cotton factory, a valuable supply train, 5,000 acres of Confederate cotton.
1863.—A cavalry force under Col. Tolland, of the Thirty-fourth Ohio mounted infantry, burned Lynchville, Va. Federal loss was 65, including Col. Tolland; that of the Confederates 75 killed and many wounded.
1861.—News that Gen. Forrest had been killed, wounded by Gen. Smith at Tupelo, Miss., confirmed. Confederate loss 2,500.
1861.—Two severe battles in Georgia. Gen. Hood attacks Gen. Sherman's army, with a loss of 20,000 in killed, wounded and prisoners. Union General McPherson killed on the 22nd.
1861.—Battle at Winchester, Va., between Gen. Early and Gen. Averill. The Confederates retreated with loss.
1868.—Bill to exclude the electoral votes of the non-organized States voted by the President and re-passed by Congress.
1870.—Suicide of M. Prevost Paradol, French Minister at Washington.
1881.—Theodore Roosevelt, of New York, who had been a delegate to the Chicago convention, declared his intention to vote for McKinley at Washington.
1888.—Chief Justice of the United States Supreme Court Melville W. Fuller sworn in.
1898.—A dispatch from Gen. Miles said: "We have the Massachusetts, Dixie Gloucester, Cincinnati, Annapolis, Leyden, Wasp, Yale and Columbia. We expect to sail for Porto Rico in 24 or 36 days." The number of troops conveyed from Guantanamo was 3,415.
1898.—Jan. Leonard R. Wood made military Governor of Santiago.
1899.—Five Italians lynched at Tallahassee for the murder of Dr. J. P. Hodge.
1903.—The adoption of the new currency authorized by the government began in the Philippines.
