COTTON UP 25 TO 30 POINTS

The Market Was Again Very Active, With Wide Fluctuations. Higher Cables Than Expected and Favorable Demand for Raw Cotton in European Countries.

New York, Oct. 4.—The cotton market was very active again today, with the price at a net advance of 25 to 30 points after an irregular early session. Sales for the day were estimated at fully 600,000 bales.

The opening was steady at an advance of 25 points in response to higher cables than expected and reports of a small Southern crop offering in the English market. The early weather reports were considered favorable, however, and there was heavy selling of 150,000 bales.
