POU PLAYED BUTLER

Democratic Congressman Tells Senator to His Face That He Was Responsible for the New York House-Southfield Debate Will Cease to be a Political Issue.

Smithfield, Oct. 6.—There is evidently a typographical error in the report under a column headed "The New York House-Southfield Debate Will Cease to be a Political Issue."

Butler was not more than 300 voters present instead of 3,000, and they came largely from Sampson county. Few Democrats were present because it was not known until 10 o'clock yesterday morning that there would be a joint debate.

Butler's reputation is such that the Democrats of this county do not care that he has his speech. Butler positively refused to agree to a joint discussion unless Pou would speak first.

The audience, composed of about 375 Republicans and such Democrats of the county as have business, was about 25 in number, had the satisfaction of seeing the ex-Populist Senator forced to sit for an hour and a half while Pou held his political record up to the scorn of every decent man present.

It had been known generally 48 hours before the debate that Mr. Pou intended to reply to Butler, there would have been a thousand Democrats present.

His opening speech of one hour has never been surpassed in this town. He charged that Butler was stopped from attacking the Democratic State administration and quoted from the Clifton Caucasian an editorial published in 1902.

Turning to Butler, he demanded to know how he was selling the truth in 1902 and 1907, or now after he has turned Radical.
