CHANGES IN ENDOWMENT BANK.

A New Class of Insurance Provided for Pythians—Maximum Available \$5,000—Rates Higher and Nearer the Old Line Insurance. Pythians throughout the State will be interested in learning something about the changes in the endowment bank which goes into effect with the new year...

In the fifth class there are five options. Option A provides insurance with a level premium, very similar to that given in the old line companies. After three years the policy becomes incontestable and on non-payment of the premium, a cash-up policy or extended insurance may be secured. The rates are less than those in the level premium companies, such as the New York Life, the Mutual Life, the Equitable, the Penn Mutual, Mutual Benefit, Northwestern and the like. Option B offers a twenty-year paid-up policy, the privilege being the same as in option A. Options C, D and E offer term policies, and others, all planned after those in vogue with the level premium companies.

MEANS MONEY TO CHARLOTTE.

The Double-Trackers and the Freight Yard Forces to Have the Rocks. The coupling of the contractors to build the Southern Railway's new freight yards and to double-track the line from here to Atlanta will mean much to this community. It is said that R. E. Royster & Co., who are already at work on the freight yards, will employ 1,000 men, principally negroes, and that the average wage will be \$1.50 a day, which will make a daily pay roll of \$1,500 or a weekly sum of \$10,500. The class of labor employed will turn the money loose, and it will go to the Charlotte merchants, the police court, the banks and to Salisbury.
