MAY PROVE ALIBI.

Three Suspects in Concord Jail Charged With Attempted Wrecking of Train No. 43. Deny Guilt—The White Boys Say They Can Prove They Were in Concord When No. 43 Passed.

It was learned yesterday that the three men arrested and incarcerated in Cabarrus jail late Friday night and early yesterday morning are confident that they can prove their innocence of the charge of attempting to wreck train No. 43 by establishing an alibi.

The two white boys, Foy Wilson and Oscar Whitesides, say they were at Concord when train No. 43 passed going South, they following on the freight. It was said, too, that they had been seen at Concord. They admitted having beaten a ride on the train. Wilson says he is from Georgia, but has relatives in Rock Hill, while Whitesides says he has a mother in Rock Hill.
