The Altitudes Along the Line and About the Terminus at Edgemont. The government contour map gives the following interesting figures showing altitudes of towns along the line of the Carolina & North Western Railroad and of points of interest around Edgemont, the present terminus:
Chester, S. C., 538 feet; Yorkville, S. C., 722 feet; Gastonia, 732 feet; High Shoals 724 feet; Lincolnton 840; Newton 1,018; Hickory 1,164 feet; Granite Falls 1,200 feet; Tryland 1,298; Lenoir 1,142 feet; Setzers 1,345 feet; Mortimer 1,525 feet; Edgemont 1,650; Hibernia, four miles from Lenoir, 2,265 feet; Hugh's Ridge at Edgemont, 1,500 feet; Grandmother mountain, six miles from Edgemont, 4,886; Grandfather mountain, 10 miles from Edgemont, 5,964 feet; Adams Knob, four miles from Collettsville, 2,600 feet; Chestnut mountain, four miles from Mortimer, 3,400 feet; Warrior's mountain, four miles from Lenoir, 2,400 feet.
