SENATE TACKLES TRUSTS

Senator Hansbrough Complains That He is Marked for Slughter in His State by the "Harvester Trust" and Urges Action—The Penal Code Under Discussion Again. Washington, Jan. 22.—The Senate spent over an hour to-day in discussing a resolution offered by Senator Hansbrough, of North Dakota, directing the Department of Commerce and Labor to suspend its investigation into the affairs of the International Harvester Company, which was ordered by a resolution over a year ago. During this discussion Senator Hansbrough declared that the "harvester trust" is attempting to control the selection of delegates to the next Republican national convention and is especially plotting to defeat him for re-election. The resolution was finally referred to the committee on agriculture.
