1. The present structure is inadequate to the necessities of the situation. Our city is growing and the need of a modern, commodious, well-equipped building has become imperative...

2. In our judgment, the longer the erection of the new building is delayed, the greater will be our loss of prestige and honor...

3. We desire to show our love to the Saviour in the most effective manner. Jesus is not here in bodily form...

It originated from the private hospital, which was for several years owned and run by three of the leading physicians of the town...

In January, 1903, 10 physicians of the North Carolina Medical College each paid something over \$2,000, and bought the equipment of the private hospital...

The building then occupied was the former site of the old city hall, which was given the name of "The Presbyterian Hospital..."

Through the endeavors of the Presbyterian ladies, under the leadership of Mrs. George H. Brockenbrough, the women's ward was furnished at a cost of something over \$500...

Private rooms were furnished by the First and Second churches, the Alexander home, the Masons and the Knights of Pythias lodges...

Owing to the growth of the work and the larger building, a great deal more equipment was needed almost at the beginning...

The sum of \$3,815.13 is the total sum of contributions. The hospital, in the five years, has given to the charity work \$10,078.70...

The physicians and nurses have been untiring in their work, and all charity cases have been treated with as much kindness and thought as those that were able to pay their way...

The training school has grown to 20 nurses. Fourteen nurses have graduated in the past five years. Eleven are nursing in Charlotte...
