

FOR EMERGENCY CURRENCY BILL THROUGH LOWER HOUSE

By a Vote of 168 to 140 the Compromise Bill Drafted by the Republican Conference Passed the House...

The day began with a continuation of yesterday's conference between the Republican representatives of the two houses...

After several speeches by several of the Democratic conferees in criticism of the course of the Republican currency legislation...
