VISITORS WALKED TO THEIR VICTORY

Redford Passed Nine Batters and Hit One, Leading the Game to Greensboro 4 to 6—Hammerley Kept the Half Dozen Hits Off Him Well Scattered—Game Was Too Slow to Be Interesting and Umpire

Greensboro walked to victory yesterday afternoon, winning without effort 4 to 0, largely because of Redford's wildness. He allowed one score by a wild throw and later forced another man thru. The locals scored five hits off Hammerley, but these counted for nothing. Sharp lines out in the second inning which would have gone to the fence on a fly field. Rain which continued heavily until only a few minutes before the game made the work of the teams slow and rather uninteresting.

Umpire Westervelt, who has hitherto held a good reputation here, lost it in the contest yesterday by refusing to see strikes that Redford was throwing. Two decisions on second base displayed a degree of incompetency that admits proper language to characterize. His work was worse than amateurish.

Anthony got his base on balls and went to second on Doak's sacrifice. McKevitt drew his base also. Cogswell fled out to Brennan and Sisson grounded out third to first.
