DIVIDES SCHOOL MONEY

BOARD OF EDUCATION ACTS A Grand Total of Over \$63,000 Realized From All Available Sources—City Gets Slightly Over \$21,000—Special Taxes Remain More Than \$40,000 to Swell the Fund—Apportionment in Detail by Townships and by Schools—Payment to State Treasurer on the Loan Fund Account as Recorded by Secretary—Board's First Meeting of Year.

A total of \$63,561.27, accruing from a wide variety of sources, to compose the gross financial assets of the school fund of Mecklenburg county, was apportioned yesterday by the board of education at what was not only its first but its most important meeting of the year. Of this amount the city gets away with \$21,256.80 and the county outside the city, \$27,492.75. To the building fund goes \$1,205.52, expenses being allowed for.

The appropriation to the city is made on the basis of \$2.55 for each person of school age, while in the county the per capita rate is \$2.45. The following detailed statement is self-explanatory.

By order of the board of education the school funds for the scholastic year 1908-1909 be apportioned as follows:

ANOTHER GREAT PLAY.

Charlotte fills the Academy of Music to see "The Right of Way" Fine Acting and Superb Scenery But the Crowning Touches to a Stirring Play.

Running the gamut of human emotions with a consummate skill that scarcely "The Right of Way" can rival, the dramatic artistry of Mr. Gilbert Percepsis striking novel, "The Right of Way," was fresh laurels last night before a splendid Charlotte audience, which was a credit to the city and which, taken in connection with that which witnessed Blanche Walsh in "The Test," goes far toward establishing a dramatic reputation here which extends beyond the realm of scenic opera.

The exceptional opportunity which the play presents to artists in character impersonation found adequate appreciation in the superb cast which, headed by two first-class stars, Mr. Gilbert Percepsis and Mr. Theodore Bonn, and aided by time-honored scenic effects, created for the eyes of the audience a world which for the most part possessed elements of the most deceptive realism.

In no degree was "The Right of Way" as a play a disappointment to those who had read the book. It was easily recognizable and possessed, as it does, without the slightest rhetorical twirl or circumstance of any kind, a dramatic interest and a dramatic truthfulness that had the book at its base a pleasant surprise to those who feared conformity to the text of the book at the cost of spectacular heart-drawing.

From Mr. Standing as Guy Steele, perhaps the most difficult task of characterization and to say that he measured up in a very commendable degree to the demand of his part is to pronounce his performance faultless. A heart in turn which has an inevitable tragedy of life, set on the surface an intellectual questioning, building ends applying to all things the steel of remorseless logic.

His former habit of thought, which completely from his consciousness, a surgical operation reveals his dominant self and synchronously may become the battle ground of a dual personality of conflicting elements.

Of the final quality also was Mr. Robert's work as Joe Portogues, a primary question. If his part was left to be decided in this important play, it required a very high standard of the art historian to point it out. Others in whose praise last night's audience was singing are Mr. Paul (Harry) as Supon, Miss May (Lillian) as Rosalie and Miss Evelyn Hammond as Mrs. Kestel and Miss Evelyn Wells as Pauline De Bois.
