New York, Jan. 27.—The cotton market just about lost yesterday's gain during the day's trading, the price being barely steady at a net decline of 10 to 15 points. The market opened steady at a decline of 1 point to an advance of 3 points, and notwithstanding rather disappointing...

Private advices concerning the spot situation were somewhat conflicting, reports from Memphis claiming that middle men who had bought cotton for a speculation were letting some of it go around present prices while a leading Eastern belt handler reported a good export demand and firm holders.

STOCK MARKET.

New York, Jan. 27.—Prices of stocks were lifted in various quarters of the day without much difficulty. The dealings were not active at any time but demand was lax and the supply offering for sale was so considerable that light buying sufficed to make an impression on prices.

Chicago, Jan. 27.—Political news from abroad of a disquieting nature had a tendency to strengthen the wheat market here today. At this close, which was almost at the best point of the day, prices were up 1/4 and 1/2 c., compared with yesterday's close. Corn also closed strong at net gains of 1/4 to 3/4 c.
