

BURT JOHNSON GETS DOCTOR'S DEGREE FROM COLUMBIA U.

Columbia University of New York City has just announced that the Doctor of Education degree has been awarded to Burt P. Johnson, formerly of Lillington and now a resident of Tenafly, New Jersey.

Doctor Johnson will be remembered in Lillington as the son of the late John B. Johnson and Mrs. Norma B. Johnson Hobbs, now of Raleigh. He graduated from the Lillington high school in 1926. Two years later he graduated from Mars Hill College, and in 1930 received his B. A. degree from the University of North Carolina. Following his graduation, he served as teacher and principal of Sigling Hope school from 1930-34. In 1934 he was appointed principal of Goldshoro high school, and was there until 1939 when he was elected principal of the Junior-senior high school at Port Jervis, N. Y. In 1943 he became general supervisor and assistant to the superintendent of the public school of Belleville, N. J.

In 1945 he was appointed principal of Tenafly high school in Tenafly, N. J. Interesting to note, this school and community's per capita cost for public school education is about \$300 per child per year—one of the largest in the United States.

In addition to Doctor Johnson's regular work at Tenafly, he served

as a part-time member of the staff of secondary school administrators at Columbia University during the last two academic years and will hold the rank of full professor again in the 1948 summer session, as he did in the 1947 session.

Broadens Opportunity For Regular Army Commission Candidate

Enlisted men and officers of the Army who have had no college training now have an opportunity to compete for appointments in the Regular Army, according to information released by Headquarters Third Army recently. Enlisted high school graduates may compete for admission to the United States Military Academy to fill vacancies allotted to enlisted men of the Regular Army for admission on July 1, 1948. Eligible enlisted men selected for this competition are offered preparatory academic training in courses under the direction of the United States Military Academy. United States Military Academy preparatory training is also offered qualified officers and warrant officers on active duty in the Army, Navy, Marine and Coast Guard.

For the reserve officer with no college training the Army offers a competitive tour of duty looking to an appointment in the Regular Army. The former provision that an applicant must have had two years of college work in an accredited institution is broadened to provide that an applicant who is a graduate of an accredited high school will be acceptable provided he makes a passing score in examinations that will be provided.

William Stuart On Football Team

With the Eighth Army in Camp Mower, Kyushu, Japan, (6 November 1947)—Pfc. William M. Stuart, now on Detached Service with Cannon Company of the 34th Infantry Regiment, 24th Infantry Division, has recently gained a position on the Regimental Football Team.

Pfc. Stuart, who enlisted in the Army in October, 1946, at Fort Bragg, N. C., received his stateside basic training at Fort Eustis, Va. He arrived in the Japanese Theater of Occupation in January, 1947, and joined the 34th Infantry on the Island of Kyushu, southernmost and third largest of the Japanese home group.

Contributing to the high morale of the men of the 34th Infantry is an extensive recreation program including football, basketball, tennis, boating, roller skating, and horseback riding. Also under construction is a six lane bowling alley.

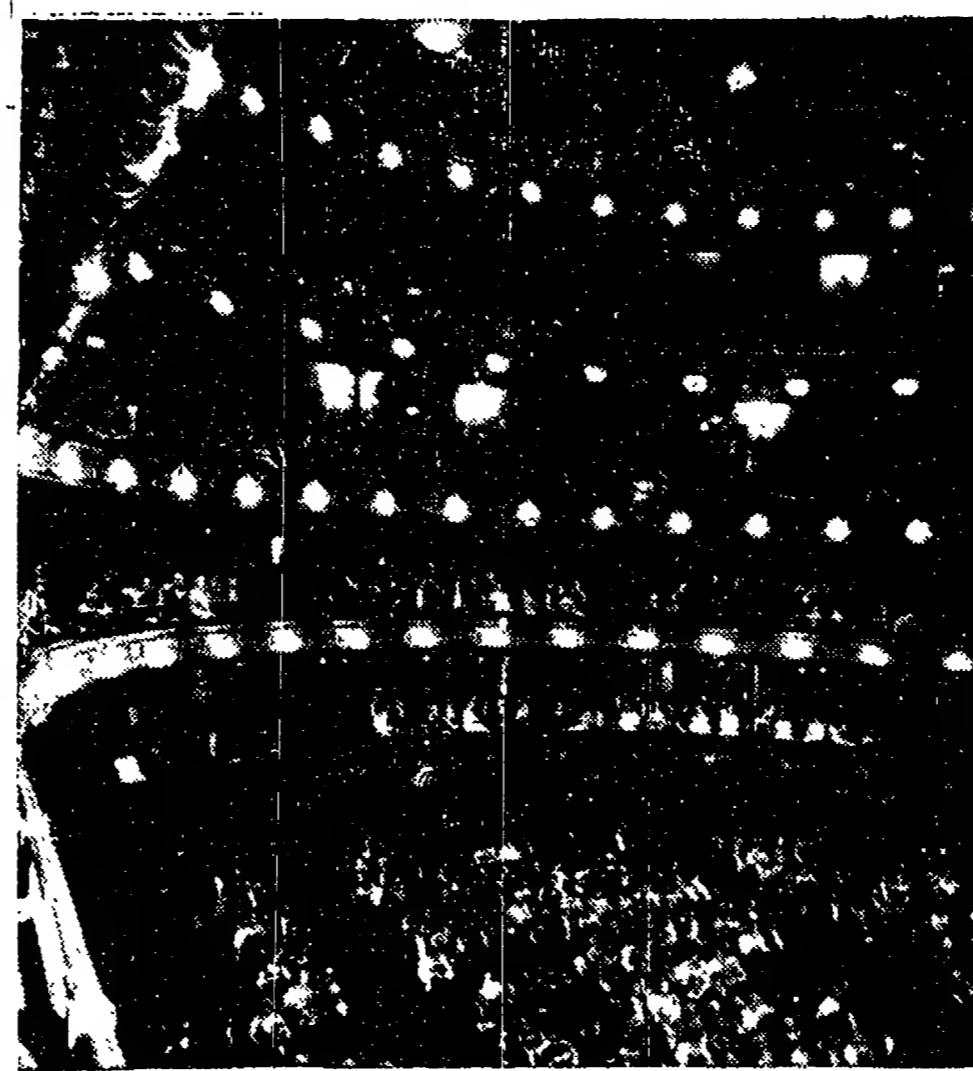

Each teacher will be given the opportunity to make a contribution. One hundred and ninety local unit presidents of the NCEA have been notified and many of the units are already collecting their

quota of funds.

The campaign funds will be forwarded from the local unit to NCEA headquarters in Raleigh. They will then be sent to the executive committee of the NEA which will allocate the money through the best established channels.

The money collected in the campaign will be used to provide food, clothing and supplies for our colleagues overseas, Miss Perkins said, and the campaign will enable us to play a practical part in the worldwide struggle between democracy and totalitarianism.


