He traced the commercial advancement of the country through the various censuses from the time of Alexander Hamilton to the present, and presented figures from the eleventh census, now made public for the first time, to show that wool and woolen manufactures had to-day increased since 1880 \$77,046,753 in value. Statistics of cotton manufactures were also made pub-He for the first time and show increases over 1880 as follows: In number of estublishments, 156; in hands employed, 48,323; in cotton consumed, (bales), 5.0.165; in value of product, \$65,674,-419; in number of spindles, 3,515,506, and in number of looms, 90,298. The greatest increase is in the Sauthern States, which are employing nearly as many hands in this industry now as New England did in 1890.




