### Assay and Reduction.

From The Land of the Sky for June.

The whole of Western North Carolina is, from its geological character, necessarily prolific in metals and minerals, useful and precious. Of the former class iron proves to be the most abundant, and as valuable and various in kind as in quantity. Copper, nickel and other metals are found less abundantly; but such minerals as corundum, mica, asbestos, talc, etc., are diffused more largely and of better quality than found elsewhere in the United States. The search for the precious metals has been general, as was natural from the splendor of the reward when search was successful.

In every county there has been more or less encouragement; but the work of mining has been prosecuted on the most primitive plans; and science has had little to do with drawing just deductions from superficial indications or in following out work to profitable conclusion. The successful application of more recondite processes to the Boilston mines has given a great stimulus to researches elsewhere. The same indications which led to valuable discoveries there will put others on a track that will enrich other localities as it promises to do the Boilston proprietors. The prospects in Henderson, in Transylvania, in Jackson, in Macon, in Cherokee, on the west side of the mountains; and on the east side, in Polk, Rutherford, Burke and McDowell are of a nature to excite the most sanguine expectations.

But while there can be no mistake in the nature of some formations, and while gold exhibits itself in palpable form and color, there are other cases that either misled by an assumed similarity to those that have proved value, or they discourage because external appearances are so indefinite as to lead to false conclusions. The most sensible want has been that of some scientific standard of test. With such, false hopes would at once be dissipated, and with such, faint hopes might be encouraged. Gold would not be found where it does not exist; and gold might be found where it is not believed to exist.

What is wanted in Western North Carolina is an assay or reduction office, placed in charge of a veritable scientific man, at a central accessible point, where ores can be examined and tested at small cost, and in reasonable time; and by which the people of the country may learn definitely whether or not the ores they find have value or otherwise.

Such a person has been found in the person of Professor Courtney de Kalb, of Syracuse N. Y., who will soon establish an assay and reduction office in Asheville.
