This, with the various special taxes, HANDSOME PROPER I FOR SALE ! would have made the total resources for the present fiscal year \$792,997-06. At the time the Treasurer made his estimates it was supposed that the Legislature would reduce tax on land from 25 to 23 cents, but it was scaled down to 20 cents. On this basis, the estimates would fall short of meeting all libilities of the State general and special. Fortunately, however, the tax valuation of property in the State has increased, according to the last assesment, to \$209,000,000, upon which at 20 cents per hundred dollars reduction, a tax of \$418,000 will be demand, which by the various special taxes will be increased to \$773,627,06. 


