

THE COTTON MARKET

Liquidation Continues Fairly Liberal and Prices Fall.

New York, Jan. 12.—The liquidation in cotton which started yesterday was fairly liberal again today and values slowly gave away. The spot business in Liverpool was better, but prices there were fractionally lower, and the report was not considered good. Our market opened one point down, may selling on the first call at 5.86. In the morning the trading was extremely dull, but in the afternoon the heavy receipts caused many discouraged holders to unload and the market weakened. May declined to 5.81 and closed at that figure with the tone of the market easy. The chances seem to us to favor lower prices.
