CIVIL SERVICE.

An Examination to be held here on June 4.

The United States civil service commission announces an examination will be held by its internal revenue board of examiners in this city on June 4, commencing at 9 a. m., for the position of storekeeper and gauger in the internal revenue service. Only citizens of the United States can be examined.

The age limitation for this examination are as follows: Minimum, twenty-one years; no maximum. No application will be accepted for this examination unless filed in complete form with the board at the internal revenue office in the city named above before the hour of closing business on May 31, 1898.

This examination is open to all reputable citizens of the United States who may desire to enter the service, and who comply with the requirements. Application blanks (Form 101), full instructions, specimen questions, and information relative to the duties and salary of the position may be obtained from H. C. Shook, secretary of the board.

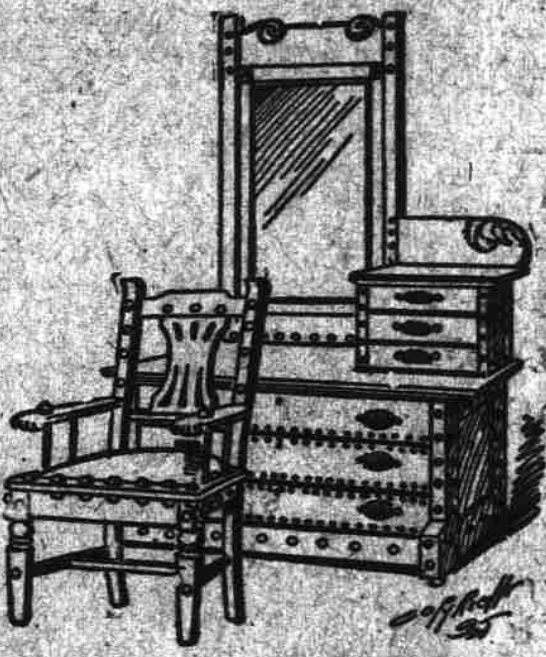
