AMERICAN TOBACCO ACTIVE

Highest, Lowest and Closing

Prices for Active Stocks

Cotton Market Point.

Reported by private wire to Murphy & Company, Stock Brokers, 11 Church Street, Asheville, N. C.

New York, June 12.—The stock market opened strong and active largely in sympathy with the material advance shown in the London prices for American stock. Little of importance indeed transpired over night with any bearing upon the market situation. One piece of news of particular importance was the purchase by the Pennsylvania of the Pennsylvania Steel company and this was reflected in a rapid advance in Pennsylvania stock upon the opening of business. The United States Steel issues were not particularly affected by the news in question and continued to fluctuate within very narrow limits. The conspicuous features of the market were again the Gould stocks, under the lead of Missouri Pacific. The opening prices for Missouri Pacific extended fully 2 points above last night's prices. Texas and Pacific advanced somewhat on an announcement that holders of the Missouri Pacific bonds intended to transfer their investment into the stock as being of particular significance and accounted in part for this morning's advance. Other active features of the and Rio Grande, St. Paul and the Atch-market were Union Pacific, the Erie lines. The American Tobacco issues continued active in the industrial quarter but showed small fluctuations and the same was true of the movements in Sugar Refining. Amalgamated Copper was the strong feature of the specialties on the favorable decision in the litigation against the company announced yesterday.

COTTON. New York, June 12.—The advance in this market yesterday met a full response at Liverpool when business was resumed today although the bear clique had anticipated otherwise. New York opened a shade lower which was decidedly disappointing to the shorts who had calculated on a sharp reaction. Soon after the opening the temper was to support the market and the tendency was higher. Crop accounts are decidedly mixed but the consensus of opinion is that the hot weather now prevailing with temperature around the nineties after the long spell of wet weather must prove disastrous to the plant and that this fact cannot fail to be recognized before long. Current public reports indicate 81 degrees temperature early in the day at a number of points. Rain was reported only at Memphis, Chattanooga, Savannah, Amarillo and Augusta, but in no instance did it exceed .22 inch. The mill situation is being widely discussed and the expectation is that buying from this source cannot long be delayed if present prospects are maintained for any length of time. Liquidation was active, holders being in a hurry to get out, owing to the condition of crop, the weather was good today and very favorable in the spring wheat region. There were rains over the entire spring wheat. Trade was active all the morning as prices declined, the decline in July breaking September 3-8 to 5-8 cent. In the winter wheat belt today the weather was fine for the maturing crop. Wheat was less active in the afternoon, rallying irregularly, closing quiet.

CORN.—There was a steady market early with a materially active at West. Prices varied but little from last night, influenced by steady cables, the large export business of yesterday and the details of the crop bulletin although the weather today was favorable all through the west. Corn was weak on July liquidation in the afternoon closing quiet. Provisions quiet and steady.

LIST YOUR PROPERTY

Give in Your Poll!

Notice is hereby given that the tax lists for the city of Asheville, Buncombe county, North Carolina, will sit in the county court house in said city every day during the month of June of the year 1901 for the purpose of receiving the tax lists of each and every person liable for tax in said city for the year 1901.

The law requires every person, male and female, residing within the corporate limits of said city of Asheville, during the month of June in each and every year, to furnish the list takers for said city a list showing all the real estate owned by him or her on the first day of June of that year. Also all personal property of every kind, giving its true cash value. Also his or her income, derived from sources not otherwise taxed. Also each and every male person under the age of fifty years and over the age of twenty-one years is required to list a poll tax, except those that are exempted by the board of county commissioners. Those holding certificates of exemption are required to list, but if he shall exhibit his certificate of exemption to the list taker, taxes will not be charged up to him on tax books.

All persons who are liable for poll tax and fall to give themselves in, and all who own property and fail to list it, will be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction fined and imprisoned. Only females and non residents of townships and persons physically unable to attend and file their lists can appoint agents to list property.
