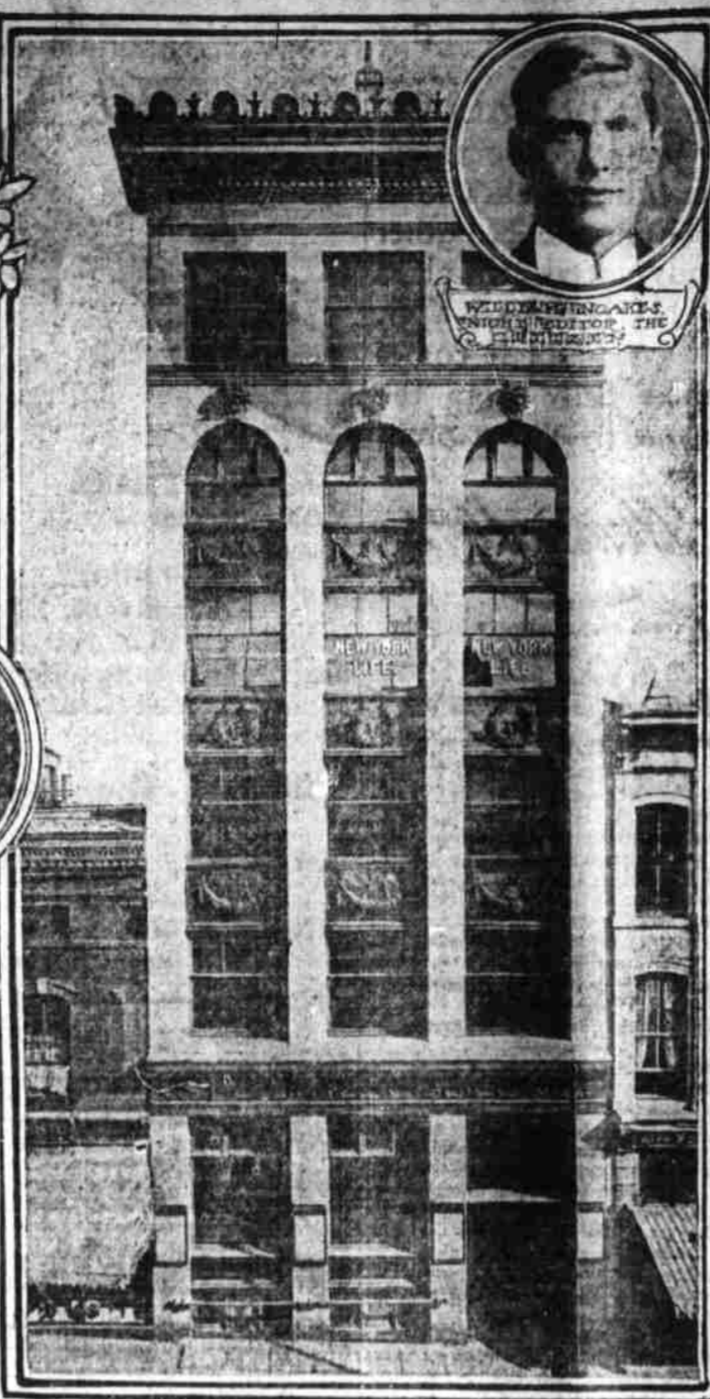

RARE COPY OF POE. Manuscript Now Worth Thousands Picked From Waste Paper Basket. Philadelphia Dispatch to New York Times. J. Pierpont Morgan's purchase for \$3,800 of a first edition of a 32-page pamphlet containing two of Edgar Allan Poe's prose stories, "The Murders in the Rue Morgue" and "The Man That Was Used Up," being to mind the fact that the original manuscript of one of the stories mentioned in the property of the Froyel Institute of this city, to which it was presented by the late George W. Childs. Mr. Childs paid \$200 for it about 30 years ago. "The Murders in the Rue Morgue" appeared originally in Graham's Magazine, published in this city back in the time of the late J. M. Johnston, a great admirer of Poe, and afterward an editor on the staff of the Lancaster Intelligencer. After the story had been put into type and the manuscript discarded Johnston recovered it from the waste basket.

For many years the manuscript had a precarious existence. Mr. Johnston after his removal to Lancaster opened a photograph gallery in that city, in which he operated until the outbreak of the civil war, when he enlisted in the Seventy-ninth Pennsylvania infantry. During his occupancy of the gallery the building was twice partly destroyed by fire, and, although nearly everything else was consumed, the Poe manuscript, which had been kept in a portfolio in a closet, was preserved. Years afterward, at housecleaning time, an ancient and apparently worthless manuscript was thrown by
