MOUNTAIN SCHOOLS. Development of Christian education n the mountainous regions of th State is perhaps as great in proportion as that of any other part of the State. The progress of educational work is really handicapped by too much talk that would lead to an idea that most of it is of the missionary character. People in the western part of the State find these tones of re ported missionary and uplift work more or less disagreeable

The Appalachian Industrial and Training School at Boone and the Cullowhee Normal Industrial School n Jackson county are as much State astitutions, supported by the State s is the university, the Normal col ge at Greensboro, and A. and M llege at Raleigh, and the Eastern arolina Training School at Green They feel that they are entitled the dignity of being known as State estitutions. They have never been listinctly charged with being mission ary institutions, and yet the multitud ous talk of missionary and other plift work has become more or lescttached to the idea of educations ork in the whole of western North arolina.

The same is more or less true o other schools which are in a degree under denominational influence as for example, the school at Valle Cru cis, operated under the direction Bishop Horner, and the school i Sanner Elk, operated for the Concor Presbytery, under the immediat harge of Rev. Mr. Edgar Tufts There are many institutions which are in the category of missionary work particularly, but the work these is sometimes more or less misunderstood, because of the relates to China or Korea doesn't souch the mountain country at all either in North Carolina or Tennessee The Chinaman must be led entirely b the missionary, but the Christian and ducational spirit of western North Carolina is one of self-help to a ver irge degree, or, more particularly one of self-reliance. It is true that in many cases there is need of money still, this is not in the sense of re ceiving missionary help as ordinarily understood, but a little help supplementary to the people's own effortsforts which are very so-cessful, with the sympathy and support of the State itself and of citizens in other parts of

North Carolina. Nobody who has any acquaintant with the work of the schools mentioned needs to be told that the spiri ctuating their management is en tirely unexceptionable, from the standpoint of the mountain folks and every one else. It is only wrong imprestions on the part of the outsiders re garding them and their relations with the people around them that give rise to the feeling described.—Charlotte Observer.
