New York, Dec. 8. - Prices were slightly lower at the opening of the stock market today. Most railroad issues opened steady at a decline of 1 to 2 points and sold off to a net loss of 13 to 15 points before the first hour ended, under scattered liquidation and local bear pressure, which was encouraged by the census report showing 12,314,332 bales ginned to December 1st.

John Barrett, Director General of the Pan-American Union, favors making the Panama Canal free to the shipping of the world. In a recent interview he said: "A free canal, at a conservative estimate, will carry in the first year \$75,000,000 more of the products of the United States than a toll canal. At this rate for ten years, without even counting the natural growth from year to year, the increase will pay for the entire original cost of the canal at a liberal interest on the investment of \$750,000,000."
