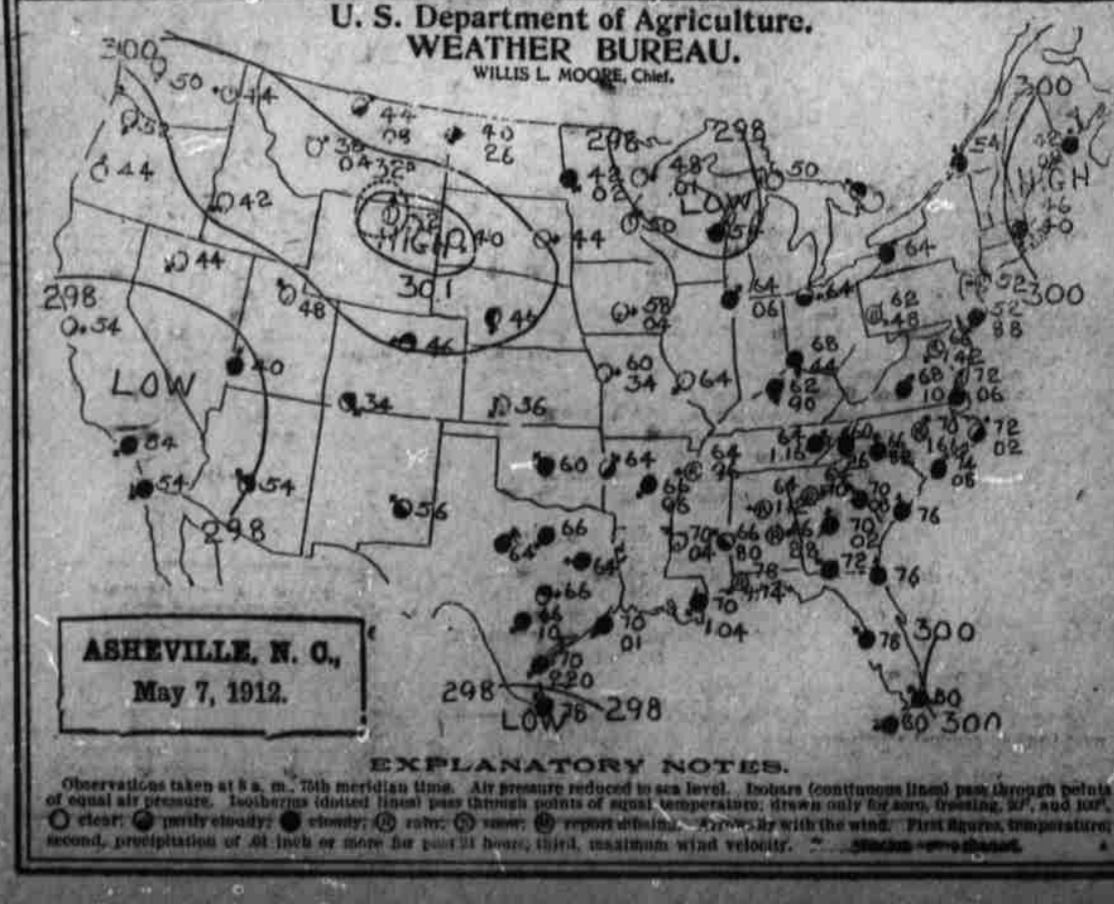
PALACE THEATER HAS SOME GLEVER FEATURES
