

TOURISTS PLAYED EXCELLENT GAME

Watson Pitched Star Ball, Allowing One Hit—Results of Other Games.

Several very agreeable things happened in the game with Raleigh yesterday, the most important being that Asheville won and by the score of 3 to 1. Scarcely less pleasing was the demonstration by Barbare that he could "come back." He lined out two hits out of three times at bat, the first of which was for three bases. Then Doak continued to swing the sphere, and Watson had not lost his rabbit's foot. Holland also did some hitting. The home crowd had the visitors outclassed, both in hitting and in batting. It was one of the most satisfactory games of the season. Watson has probably never pitched a better game. He yielded only one hit and was in real danger only once—when Raleigh scored. In seven innings only three Capitals arrived at bat and few of them went past first. Watson was a little wild at times but could always emerge from the pinches.

Mehaffey gave the impression of being a good pitcher but he was not effective yesterday. He started out by fanning four of the first five men, although he gave up a single to the first. He made two wild throws, one counting for a run and the other edging a man. There were two or three plays of the usual capital variety. Cruthers, Mack and Butts pitched just back of second base and let a high one fall, each generously picked by the other two. Lidgate apparently went to sleep in the sixth and Corbett stole home, while the pitcher was holding the ball, in one inning. Asheville could not score with three hits and a sacrifice. Noojin did some excellent catching at center and Parry performed with his usual brilliancy at third. The infield was hard worked and held almost perfectly.
