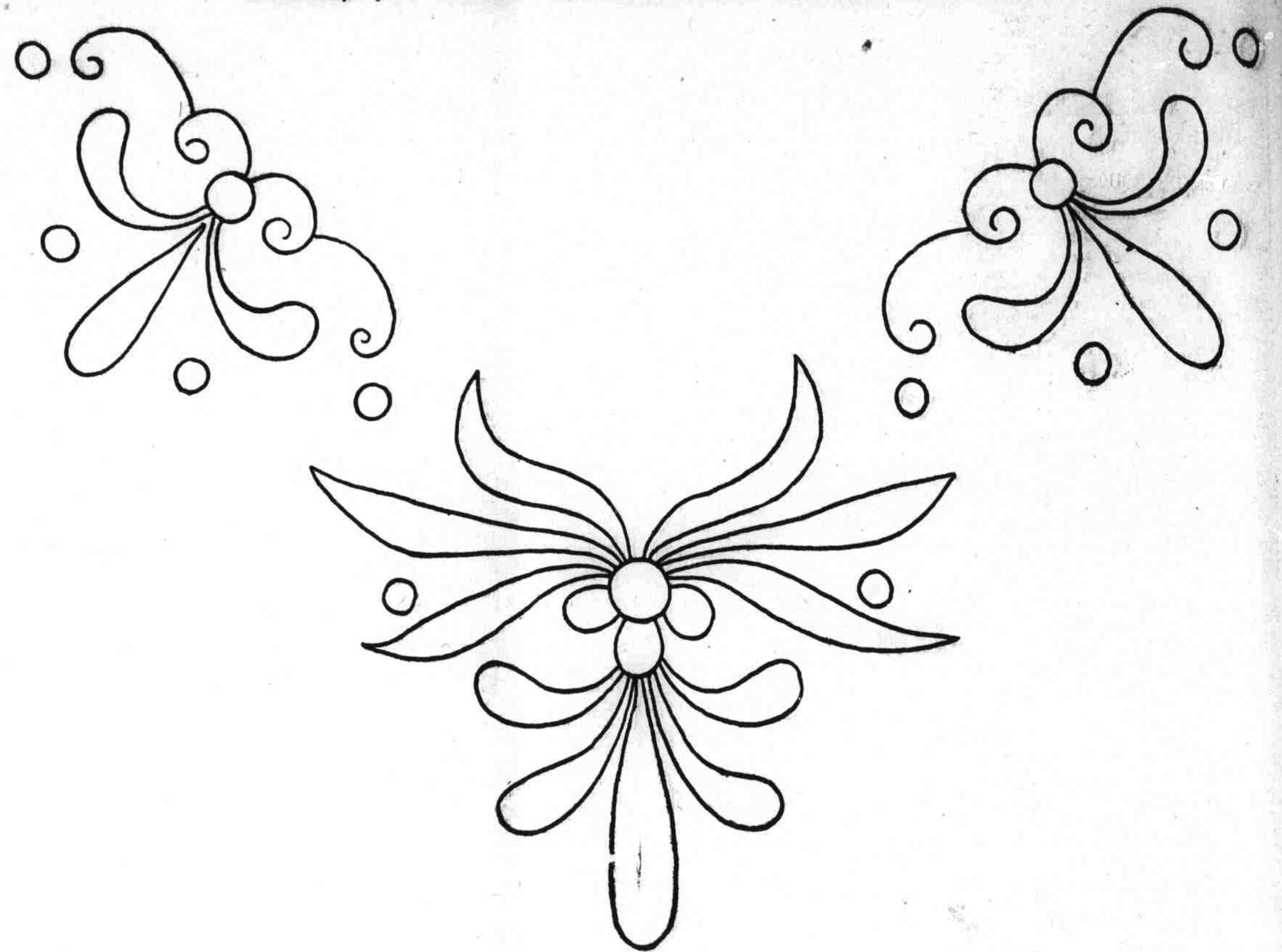

Motif for End of Scarf or Small Pillow



This motif may be done in the new Bulgarian embroidery. The work is entirely solid and is done in bright colors, reds, blues, yellows and greens. An outlining of each figure in black adds to the effect. Use mercerized cotton No. 18.

DIRECTIONS FOR TRANSFERRING.—In taking off these patterns, lay a piece of impression paper upon the material, place the newspaper pattern over this, and with a hard, flat pencil draw firmly over eachline. If the material is sheer it may be laid over the pattern and drawn off with pencil, as the design will show through.
