IN TITLE BOUT

Princeton, N. J., March 14. - In the Princeton university gymnasium tomorrow night will take place the first of the contests to decide the Inter-collegiate Wrestling acrobatic championships. The bouts will take place Saturday. The colleges represented in the tournament will include Fordham, Columbia, Cornell, Princeton and Lehigh. William Lewis of Fordham and G. A. Clark of Princeton are believed to have been selected to referee the match.

Chicago, March 14. - St. Patrick's day will be celebrated tomorrow with a festival of sticuffs that will extend pretty well over the country. Boxing bouts will be put on by clubs in many cities, and several of the bouts will be of more than ordinary interest. One of these will be the Fred Fulton-Jim Flynn 10-round affair at Milwaukee. If Fulton wins he will challenge the winner of the Willard-Moran fight for a 20-round bout in New Orleans. The St. Paul club will offer an attractive card in the shape of a 10-round setto between Mike Gibbons, the local idol, and Jeff Smith, a New Jersey scrapper. At Tulsa, Okla., Carl Morris is scheduled to go 10 rounds with Gunboat Smith, whose championship light was snuffed by Sam Langford.
