The signatures, which in the genuine notes, are written with very black ink, in the counterfeits are written with a pale yellowish ink.

The upper border of the genuine notes consists of eighteen blocks, each containing the words "ten dollars"—the counterfeits have but seventeen.

The small vignette at the bottom and centre of the note, in the genuine note is a female figure seated on an iron chest...
