

EXPERIMENTS IN WHEAT RAISING.—In the autumn of 1854, Mr. J. G. Andros, an enterprising farmer residing in the southern part of Guilford County, measured off a portion of his land, the soil of which was a poor sandy loam. On this he put a moderate quantity of stable manure, and plowed it under. He then scattered on the same acre one hundred bushels of unbleached ashes, and as he proceeded them from the furnace, and sowed the seed in the usual manner. The ground thus prepared in a thorough husbandry, and again gave it a thorough harrow, and at the harvest of 1855, Mr. A. reaped from this acre 287 bushels of excellent wheat.

In the autumn of 1855, Mr. Anthony again sowed the same ground down in the same kind of wheat, but without any additional manuring, and at the harvest of 1856, the yield was the same as the preceding year, viz, 287 bushels.

Mr. A. has sowed the same land in wheat this fall, that he may ascertain the result of a third crop in succession on the same soil. We learned the above facts from a communication with Mr. Anthony, and publish them, that we may incite others to experiment in the agricultural art, and thus arrive at greater perfection in this noble science.—Greensboro Patriot.
